Report downed power lines to the police. Continue to listen to the local news and NOAA Weather Radio for updates following the storm. If you lose power and are ...

Strong winds and falling trees can knock down power lines, especially during powerful storms. Downed power lines are dangerous -- you should not touch them, even if they're not ...

Report downed power lines to your local utility emergency center and the police. Driving during a high wind event: Keep both hands on the wheel and slow down to a safe driving speed. Stay ...
